Project Overview:

A linear park, behind the historic Porter Center in Shelbyville, will be constructed to encourage trail users to utilize the west section of the Shelby County trail system. Despite the current attractions at this location, the historic Porter Center and public art sculpture, the section of the trail immediately to the west is very unattractive and unwelcoming. The large area of deteriorated asphalt will soon become a destination for all trail users alike. With a new gateway, landscaping, raingarden, rest area and a Shelby County history storybook trail the area will be transformed.

With the help of the MIBOR ECDC grant of \$7,000 and the additional \$4,500 from the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) Placemaking Grant, Shelbyville will have the opportunity to enhance and revitalize a space that can be used to foster a healthier, more social and economically viable community.
