PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Monrovia Park and Recreation Board and the Town of Monrovia are in the early stages of developing the town's park system. In 2023 a playground and a parking lot was installed at the town's first community park. The parking lot is the only entrance to the park, and it sits between two residential homes. When the Park and Recreation Board planned the parking lot, they took into consideration how having vehicles pulling into parking spots would affect the homeowners, therefore the parking spots are set back from the road, so the cars are parking behind the houses. With funding from the MIBOR Community Impact Initiative the parking lot entrance has been completed with trees, a fence along the edge between the lot and the homes next door and a bike rack.
