Project Overview:

The MIBOR ECDC invested \$2,916 into the Boone County Community Garden. The purpose of this grant is for funding the annual recurring garden expenses and for the addition of new infrastructure, both of which will facilitate increased production of produce. Funds will also be used for Community Outreach in the form of providing more fresh produce for BCCG's current organizational partners, education and publicity expenses.

Building on the success in addressing food insecurity in Boone County, the organization plans to extend their community outreach in order to further share accomplishments in the Production Garden with the Boone County community and be a demonstration garden for a number of great garden practices. The items requested with this grant will help BCCG continue to build and expand on their previous experience and continue to provide produce and knowledge to various local organizations who currently benefit from the production garden.
