Project Overview:

Main Street Greensburg is in the process of completing an Alley Activation to pay tribute to the significance of their community's Bicentennial. The Alleyway will be a longlasting, legacy type project that will provide the community with something tangible to remember the occasion, and additionally, will improve functionality and accessibility to the Downtown District with parking more clearly designated, and a safe, beautiful, well-lit passageway to encourage and promote shopping, dining, investment, and development in the area. Further, the alleyway falls within the larger ArtsIsTREE District, an officially designated Arts District that stretches along Main Street, from Rebekah Park to the local community theater playhouse, and will complement many other recent developments in the Downtown District, including already-completed murals and the sidewalk project along the south side of the Courthouse Square.
